Spiritual Significance

In Islam, the Ameen Ceremony marks the completion of the recitation of the Holy Qur'an for the first time by a child.

It is a celebration of gratitude to Allah and the Ahl al-Bayt (A.S.), thanking the Almighty for knowledge and guidance.

It emphasizes ilm (knowledge), iman (faith), and akhlaq (character).

Traditional Sequence

1. Commencement - Child recites Bismillah and final verses of Surah Al-Naas.
2. Ameen Dua - Led by Mrs. Nargis Mukadam; includes Surah Al-Fatiha, Salawat, and Dua for Ilm.
3. Zikr & Salawat - Guests collectively recite 'Allahumma Salle Ala Muhammadin wa Aale Muhammad'.
4. Tashakkur - Dua of gratitude for completion of Qur'an.
5. Tasbeeh-e-Fatima (A.S.) - Recitation of 34x Allahu Akbar, 33x Alhamdulillah, 33x Subhanallah.
6. Naat & Manqabat - Performed by women, honoring Qur'an, Prophet, and Ahl al-Bayt.
7. Felicitation - Qur'an and Chadar presented to Rumera as a blessing.
8. Majlisi Dua (Optional) - Short dua for ilm, faith, and marhumeen.
